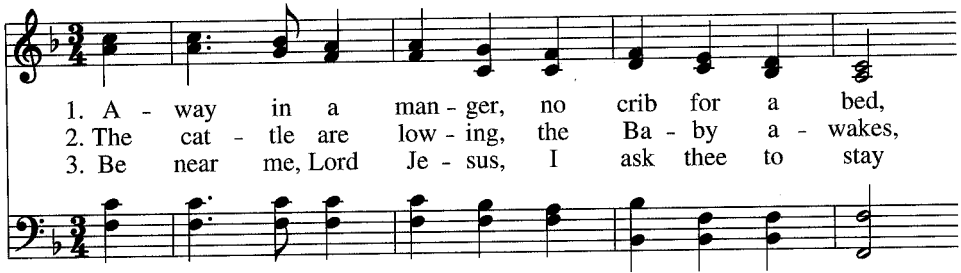
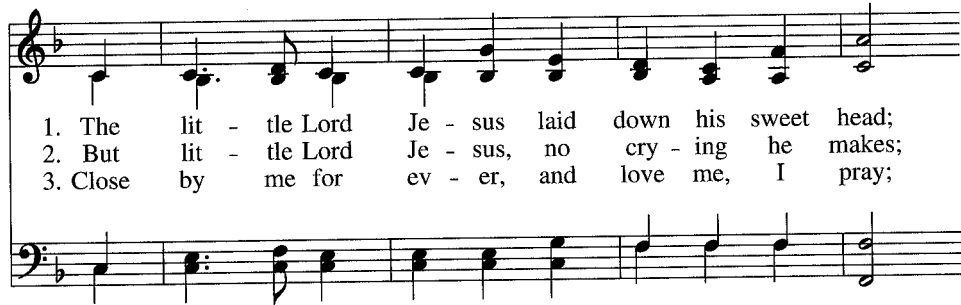


Away in a Manger



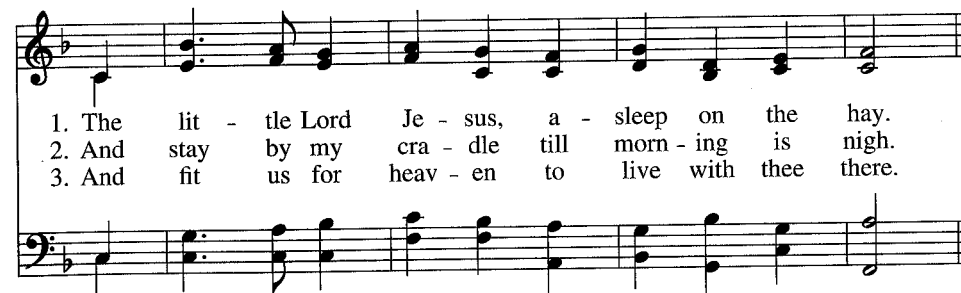
1. A - way in a man - ger, no crib for a bed,
