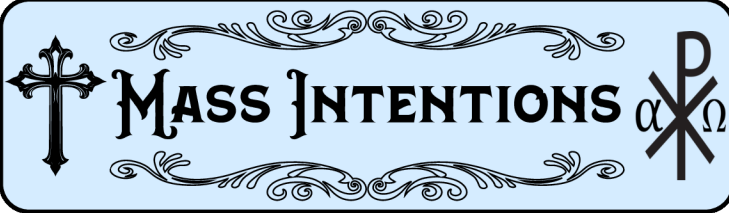

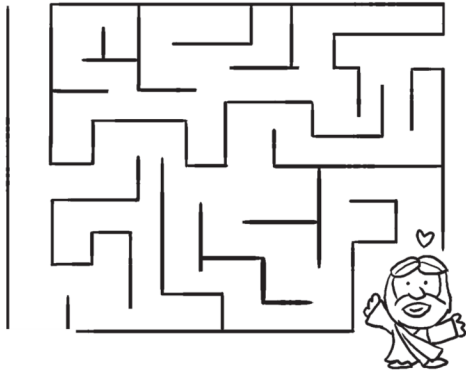

# THE PASTOR'S CORNER

My friends, let us REJOICE! Yes, rejoice in this Lenten season! Some may ask why joy? Isn't Lent supposed to be a time of prayer and penance, and reflection on the Lord's Passion? It is, yes; however, it's also an opportunity to see our Lenten journey as a way for us to become free. We exercise our Lenten disciplines: Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving, and Listening and Togetherness in order for us to see ourselves the way that God wants us to be seen as. For many of us, we don't necessarily have the opportunity, nor think of it, to view ourselves the way God sees us. It's hard and challenging, and there is no answer as to 'how' because it's different for everyone. The thing is though we each are created by God for a unique purpose, and we need to see the truth, goodness, and beauty of God in us in order for us to fulfill the God-given mission we have been created for.

In our First reading today, Samuel was instructed by God to go and anoint the new king of Israel as King Saul has fallen out of favor with God. When Samuel arrives at Jesse's house in Bethlehem to see which of his sons is chosen to become the next anointed king, Samuel only views them from his own human outward perspective; and yet the Lord responds to him in saying, "Do not judge from his appearance or from his lofty stature, because I have rejected him. Not as man sees does God see, because man sees the appearance but the Lord looks into the heart." This last part is very reflective, especially as it falls along the lines of what was stated before. Samuel was only relying only on his own human ingenuity, when in reality, he neglected to put on the eyes of God in order to look into the heart of each one. Why the heart? Because the heart is what compels all peoples- even you and I- to choose right from wrong, to discern or just act on instinct, etc... Our minds sometimes play tricks on us, and we become manipulated because we are fed by so many different lies and unanswered truths that the world provides, where many people have not discerned what is good, pleasing, and perfect through the eyes of the Lord.

When we get to our Gospel passage for today, most preachers look past the 'why' in this event. We can keep preaching on the blindness of faith as much as we want, but it doesn't go anywhere in human hearts. What this passage is supposed to interpret for us is actually what Jesus said at the very beginning after his disciples asked whether the blind man sinned or his parents. Jesus responds in saying, "Neither he nor his parents sinned; it is so that the works of God might be made visible through him." The man, yes, saw in darkness, but now he sees in the light because of the Lord- but as Jesus said, "so that the works of God might be made visible through him." The blind man was a vessel in order for the world to see the magnificence of God revealing His power of good in the world. This man now sees as God sees.

My friends, our reflection of the Power of the Cross becomes very significant now: as Jesus hangs on the cross, whipped and scourged, and dying, God is revealing to us what we look like. In other words, in viewing the Cross, we see ourselves, all of humanity, the way God sees us now. However, that all changes at the Resurrection; but we have to discern in our hearts the path we take. It may be easy to say 'I am a good person and I don't see myself that way,' but we are living the lie the world has given to us. But when we see ourselves on the Cross with Christ, we then change our sight from seeing the darkness that is beneath us, and can look up to the light we are promised.

## CONNECTICUT MARCH FOR LIFE SET FOR MARCH 18 IN HARTFORD

This year will mark the sixth annual Connecticut March for Life, a day for pro-life advocates to communicate to the Connecticut State Legislature their desire to protect and safeguard all human life.

Note: This year's events will begin earlier. The 2026 Connecticut March for Life is set for March 18 with the rally at 11:30 a.m. on the grounds of the Connecticut State Capitol, located at 210 Capitol Ave., Hartford, followed by the march around Bushnell Memorial Park at 12:30 p.m.

At 10:30 a.m., there will also be a pre-rally concert at the Capitol with praise and worship music, courtesy of the worship team at Revelation Church from Bozrah.

"Many people, especially politicians, believe there is little opposition to abortion in our state. This March sends a much different message," says Deacon David Reynolds, associate director of public policy for the Connecticut Catholic Public Affairs Conference, the public policy and advocacy office of Connecticut's Catholic Bishops.

"Not everyone in Connecticut is happy with the complete lack of restrictions on abortion in our state," the deacon says. "In past years thousands have attended the March. The larger that number, the stronger the pro-life voice will be in Connecticut. It also gives pro-life

legislators in our state, which are few in number, the support they need to continue the fight for life."

Organizers of the March are asking all Catholics to join them to signal their support for protecting all human life, from conception to natural death.

"Catholic social teaching requires us to be thoughtful citizens," Chris Healy, executive director of the Connecticut Catholic Public Affairs Conference, said in a recent video at the start of this year's legislative session. "Your voice matters when it is heard, so be heard."

Healy advises staying informed about issues that affect your values, getting to know your elected officials, and making a commitment to attend the Connecticut March for Life at the State Capitol. He will be one of the speakers at the March for Life.

This year's main speaker will be Radiance Foundation's Ryan Scott Bomberger, whose birth mother gave him up for adoption.

In addition to Healy, the roster of other speakers includes: Jennie Bradley Lichter, president, March for Life; Peter Wolfgang, president, Family Institute of Connecticut; Gerry Williams, radio show host for WIHS and master of ceremonies; Bishop Richard F. Reidy, Bishop of Norwich,

who will offer the closing prayer; and Pastor Jeremiah Johnson of Vox Church, Hartford.

The Connecticut Pregnancy Care Coalition is also sponsoring a student sign contest with prizes for the best handmade signs, with judging at 11 a.m.

Prior to the event, Healy recommends scheduling an appointment to speak with your legislator on March 18 to discuss your concerns about any possible bills. Or you can stop in to make a future appointment. You can also write a polite letter or e-mail, sharing your concerns.
